The following changes to the Eugene Elks #357 By-Laws dated 01/04/24, will be voted on at the July 17, 2024 Lodge meeting. Proposed changes approved by the Board of Directors on June 17,204 and presented to the Lodge Members on June 19, 2024.

ARTICLE V: ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES.

Remove: Sec 3. OF THE ESTEEMED LEADING, LOYAL, AND LECTURING KNIGHTS:

For the faithful performance of duties, the Secretary shall receive compensation computed in compliance with applicable minimum wage laws and as approved in the Lodge budget adopted under Statutes 12.070 and/or 16.020.
